Our Impact

Some of the ways we have worked to improve healthcare access, knowledge, and performance include:

BETTER ACCESS



Our disability determination experts bring an intricate understanding of state and federal regulations and typically take **42-60 days** to complete the determinations, well below the required federal Medicaid regulation of 90 days. Accurate decisions and expedited processing times ensure Medicaid agencies—and their members—receive prompt and appropriate disability determinations and thus members get access to care.

Our team has a four-pronged Medicare Eligibility Enhancement solution, encompassing Medicare data assurance review, entitlement correction, enrollment support, and premium payment review. **Over 98% of Medicaid members** agree to apply for Medicare when engaged and supported by our team. **More than 9,000 Medicaid members** have been enrolled in Medicare since FY14 in one state, resulting in **over \$115 million in new cost savings**.

BETTER KNOWLEDGE



Our team screens **500 newborns each day** for **65 possible medical conditions**. With newborn screening, early detection allows for early treatment of conditions or disorders—even before symptoms—that can prevent disability or death.

A strong workforce depends on training people to have the right mix of knowledge and skills for high-demand jobs. Since 2013, more than **10,000 learners** have participated in at least one of our **160 professional development training programs**.

BETTER PERFORMANCE



Our clinical pharmacy team helps Medicaid programs avoid millions of dollars in costs while maximizing pharmacy benefits for members. For one client, our team of over 70 clinical pharmacists and 20 pharmacy technicians processed **1.2 million prior authorizations** in a **24-hour turnaround,** focusing on the best outcomes using less costly drug initiatives.

We evaluate, recommend, and implement new rate and payment methodologies to support efficient care delivery for Medicaid and other state agencies. Through our expert financial modeling, we realized **\$260 million in payments** for one state's hospitals for uncompensated care provided to Medicaid and uninsured individuals.
